According to the survey Breast cancer is the most commonly occurring cancer in women and the second most common cancer overall. Breast cancer is the most common cancer in women worldwide, with nearly 1.7 million new cases diagnosed in 2012, representing about 25 per cent of all cancers in women. Incidence rates vary widely across the world, from 27 per 100,000 in Middle Africa and Eastern Asia to 92 per 100,000 in Northern America.

It is the fifth most common cause of death from cancer in women, with an estimated 522,000 deaths (6.4 per cent of the total). It is also the most frequent cause of cancer death in women from regions characterized by lower indices of development and/or income (14.3 per cent of deaths), and the second most frequent from regions characterized by higher indices of development and/or income (15.4 per cent of deaths), after lung cancer.
